SENIOR PARENTS – Dual Enrollment Grant Deadline Extended

TSAC has extended the deadline date for the fall enrollment period. If you have not completed the on-line application for it, do so through the month of September. As a Tennessee resident if your son/daughter is enrolled in a dual-enrollment class, TSAC (Tennessee

Student Assistant Cooperation) will pay up to \$300.00 per semester tuition cost.

This year TSAC has changed the application process. No longer will you print out the application, complete the required information, and submit to the college granting dual-enrollment. The application process is done all online.

The following are steps in completing the application:

- Type in the following URL in your browser:
http://tn.gov/CollegePays/stud_par/stu_par.htm
- On the upper right hand side of the page click on "Applications"
- On the lower bottom of the middle page click on **Tennessee Dual Enrollment Grant**
- Read the directions/requirements etc then click on (On-Line Application) at the top of the page
- Complete the on-line information and click "Login"
- Scroll down and click on the Dual-enrollment Grant Fall 2009-10 (This must be completed each semester)
- Read the general requirements and instructions and click "I Agree"
- Completed required information and click "Submit"
- "Confirm" application
- Print out application copy

Note that each semester this application needs to be completed and submitted. **Listening to music** – if this is the only dual enrollment class that is being taken the application is to be submitted second semester. If you have any questions contact Mr. Djernes 423.396.2124 X417
